Car Seat Safety



- Always put your baby's car seat in the back seat of your vehicle.
- Never place a rear facing seat in front of a passenger side airbag.
- Your baby should remain rear facing until 20 pounds and 12 months of age.
- Florida State Law states that your infant must be discharged home with your car seat.
